# **Getting Started: Account Registration**

1. If you already have a login, open the YachtPilot App and log in with your email and password.

2. If you do not already have a login, tap **Register**. Next, create an account with your email and set a strong password, then tap **Register**.






### **Account Registration (Continued)**

- 3. You will need to verify your email address by clicking the **Verify account** button in the email sent by YachtPilot.
- 4. Once verified, you will be able to log in.











#### Add a Boat

1. Tap the + in the upper right corner of the **Boats** screen.



2. Enter some basic information about your boat, such as its name and type of boat, then tap **Register**.




#### **Edit Boat Details**

3. Now you have registered a boat.
Suppose you have more than one, you can continue to add more. However, only one boat may be registered with a particular Sensor.


Multiple boats will require multiple Sensors.





4. Tap the 🗹 to add any optional information.

This information will give you a more personalised experience in the app and, with more features added over time, you will enjoy further enhancements to your overall experience.







#### Set-up YachtPilot Sensor

- Before you begin, ensure your mobile device has
  Bluetooth and local network access permissions enabled,
  and is connected to the same network as the Sensor.
- 1. Tap the > to the right of **Sensors** in the list.
- 2. On the **Boat sensors** screen, tap the + .

- 3. Allow permissions and follow the prompts.
- 4. Connect to Wi-Fi network.









#### **Sensor Settings**


Only after the Sensor is paired to your mobile device, will you see your Sensor's identification number. It will be unique to your pairing.


1. Tap the > to **Sensor details** screen where you will find the hardware's serial number.



3. Following set-up you will see a new list item: **View on map**, tap that button which will take you to a map view of your boat's location.







#### **Settings**

Enter the **Settings** menu by tapping the 🐯 tab on the bottom navigation bar.



The **Settings** menu gives you the ability to set your preferences, control alerts, notification permissions as well change your **Home** screen view.

Simply toggle **Show map on app start**. You can then set which widgets you wish to display on your new home screen.



#### The Home Screen

Show map on start-up sets your new **Home** screen to look like this. With all of your boat's information in a simple and intuitive interface.





#### **Alerts**

The **Alerts** screen can be accessed by tapping the **Alerts** tile on the **Home** screen or from the **Boat details** screen.

- The Alerts screen lists all alerts from every instrument being monitored by your YachtPilot Sensor.
   Tapping the > will direct you to the Alert detail screen.
- 2. Every alert will display the date, timestamp and brief description of the event.
- 3. Tap the  $\checkmark$  to acknowledge the alert.








# **Alert Filtering and Marking All**

Efficiently manage your notifications by **filtering** specific alerts and using **Mark All** to clear or address multiple alerts at once, ensuring you stay organised and focused on what's important.







#### **Anchor Alarm**

Set customisable alerts to notify you if your boat drifts beyond a specified range, helping ensure your vessel remains securely anchored and preventing unwanted movement. Tap the **Alarm** tile on the home screen to set/ deactivate anchor alarm.
